Assessment Requirements

- check you are ready to begin this assessment.

What you need to do

1. Complete the following assessment tasks:

Observation Checklist	Be observed operating a dovetailing machine to dovetail wooden drawers. This will involve being observed:
	» Preparing to operate a dovetailing machine
	» Operating a dovetailing machine
	» Dovetailing three drawer fronts
	» Dovetailing three drawer sides
	» Selecting and using all relevant personal protective equipment according to worksite policies and procedures and manufacturer's instructions
	» Operating machinery according to woodwork machinery regulations and worksite policies and procedures.

- Answering verbal questions on the tasks involved in the
- assessment.
- Attach a photograph of completed wooden drawers.

Note: Your Assessor may choose someone to verify and/or observe your work. This person must have expertise in operating a dovetailing machine to dovetail wooden drawers and could be someone you report to, your trainer, or a supervisor or manager who works with you regularly.

- 2. You may wish to provide additional supporting evidence that proves you have the knowledge and skills required by this unit. Additional evidence may include, for example, workplace documentation you have used and/or completed, training records, photos, screenshots, printouts, videos, voice recordings.
- 3. When you have completed all assessment tasks, complete the 'Candidate evidence check' at the end of this Guide.
- 4. When you are sure you have completed and/or attached everything, contact your Assessor or Account Manager to arrange next steps.



Conditions

- » Your evidence must clearly show competence in preparing to operate and operating a dovetailing machine to dovetail wooden drawers.
- » Complete all assessment tasks yourself. Use your own words when answering questions.
- » It is expected that you will have had learning / experience of operating a dovetailing machine to dovetail wooden drawers on more than one occasion, before you are formally assessed.
- » It is likely that you will have already been observed operating a dovetailing machine to dovetail wooden drawers on more than one occasion, before you are formally assessed.
- » Personal protective equipment, appropriate to job requirements, is to be selected and used in accordance with worksite policies and procedures and manufacturer's instructions.
- » Your assessment tasks may be in an on-job or off-job environment.
- » All tasks you carry out for this assessment must be completed following workplace procedures, and comply with organisational and legislative (legal) requirements.

Definitions

- » Manufacturer's instructions are instructions provided by manufacturers of substances, equipment, and machinery used in furniture making. These instructions may include details on safe and correct handling, use and storage of substances and/or details on substance properties.
 Examples are labels on substance containers, product data sheets, and operator's manuals.
- » Worksite policies and procedures refer to documented policies and to documented or other directions provided to staff. These may include, but are not limited to, ways of managing health and safety, environmental considerations, quality, and production, and must conform to legislation. Examples include standard operating procedures, company health and safety plans, on-site briefings, and supervisor's instructions.
