Assessment Requirements

This Assessment Guide is designed to help you provide evidence of your skills and knowledge required by this unit standard.

People credited with this unit standard are able to: demonstrate knowledge of adhesives; prepare to use adhesives; and use adhesives, in furniture making.

- » talk you through this Guide, and discuss when and how you will be assessed.
- » check you are ready to begin this assessment.

What you need to do

1. Complete the following assessment tasks:

Questions	Answer questions about using adhesives in furniture making. This will involve: Dobtaining and explaining a job specification from your workplace Answering 5 questions about adhesive use in furniture making.
Observation Checklist	Be observed using adhesives in furniture making. This will involve: Selecting and using adhesives Comply with all manufacturer's instructions, MSDS and worksite policies and procedures relating to adhesive use.

Note: Your Assessor may choose someone to observe your work. This person must have expertise in using adhesives in furniture making and could be someone you report to, your trainer, or a supervisor or manager who works with you regularly.

- You may wish to provide additional supporting evidence that proves you have the knowledge and skills required by this unit. Additional evidence may include, for example, workplace documentation you have used and/or completed, training records, photos, screenshots, printouts, videos, voice recordings.
- 3. When you have completed all assessment tasks, complete the 'Candidate evidence check' at the end of this Guide.
- 4. When you are sure you have completed and/or attached everything, contact your Assessor or Account Manager to arrange next steps.



Conditions

- » Your evidence must clearly show your knowledge of and use of adhesives in furniture making.
- » Complete all assessment tasks yourself. Use your own words when answering questions.
- » It is expected that you will have had learning / experience of using adhesives in furniture making on more than one occasion, before you are formally assessed.
- » It is likely that you will have already been observed using adhesives in furniture making on more than one occasion, before you are formally assessed.
- » All tasks you carry out for this assessment must be completed following workplace procedures, and comply with organisational and legislative (legal) requirements.
- » You may be assessed against on-job or off-job tasks.
- you must show competence in at least two of the following adhesives: hot glue, PVA, aliphatic resins, contact glue, epoxy resins, casein glues, urea formaldehyde, polyurethane glue, melamine glue.
- You must select and use Personal protective equipment (PPE), appropriate to job requirements, in accordance with worksite policies and procedures and manufacturer's instructions. For this unit standard PPE includes but is not limited to gloves, respirators or masks, goggles.

Definitions

- » Manufacturer's instructions are instructions provided by manufacturers of substances, equipment, and machinery used in furniture making. These instructions may include details on safe and correct handling, use and storage of substances and/or details on substance properties. Examples are labels on substance containers, product data sheets, and operator's manuals.
- » Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) are documents containing information on toxic substances used in the worksite. It is a requirement of the Environmental Risk Management Authority that all worksites using toxic substances have an MSDS.
- Worksite policies and procedures refer to documented policies and to documented or other directions provided to staff. These may include, but are not limited to, ways of managing health and safety, environmental considerations, quality, and production, and must conform to legislation. Examples include standard operating procedures, company health and safety plans, on-site briefings, and supervisor's instructions. For the purposes of this unit standard worksite policies and procedures may also refer to the policies and procedures of an off-job training site.

Further information

The following legislation (law) applies to this unit standard:

» Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996.
