Definitions

- » Safety Data Sheets (SDS) are documents containing information on toxic substances used in the worksite.
- » Worksite policies and procedures refer to documented policies and to documented or other directions provided to staff. These may include, but are not limited to, ways of managing health and safety, environmental considerations, quality, and production, and must conform to legislation.
